Totus Tuus is a week-long Catholic summer parish mission program for youth in 1st—12th grade that is dedicated to sharing the Gospel and promoting the Catholic faith through CATECHETICAL INSTRUCTION, CHRISTIAN WITNESS, VOCATIONAL DISCERNMENT, MARIAN DEVOTION, AND EUCHARISTIC WORSHIP. The program is led by a team of young adults who are trained and commissioned to serve the youth of the diocese throughout the summer.

Five Marks of Totus Tuus

1. Proclamation of the Gospel — to arouse the Faith
2. Apologetics — examination of the reasons for our beliefs
3. Christian Witness — an experience of Christian living
4. Sacraments — especially Eucharist and Confession
5. Evangelization — an active witness of the missionary nature of the Catholic Church
